Directions to Ground

By rail or bus (335 or 336) to Chalfont and Latimer Station (L.T.). Leave from "Up" platform, turn very sharp left at bottom of approach road, along Bedford Avenue, then first right up Chenies Avenue, first left along Elizabeth Avenue, Ground is 150 yards on right.

By car—(a) From Amersham follow A404 to White Lion, Amersham Common, turn left into Bell Lane, first right into Elizabeth Avenue. Ground is 300 yards on left.

(b) From Chalfont St. Giles to Little Chalfont, then left along A404 for half mile to White Lion, Amersham Common, turn left into Bell Lane, then as (a) above.

(c) From Rickmansworth follow A404 to where road bends left 200 yards before railway bridge at Chalfont and Latimer Station, turn right into Elizabeth Avenue. Ground is half mile on right.
