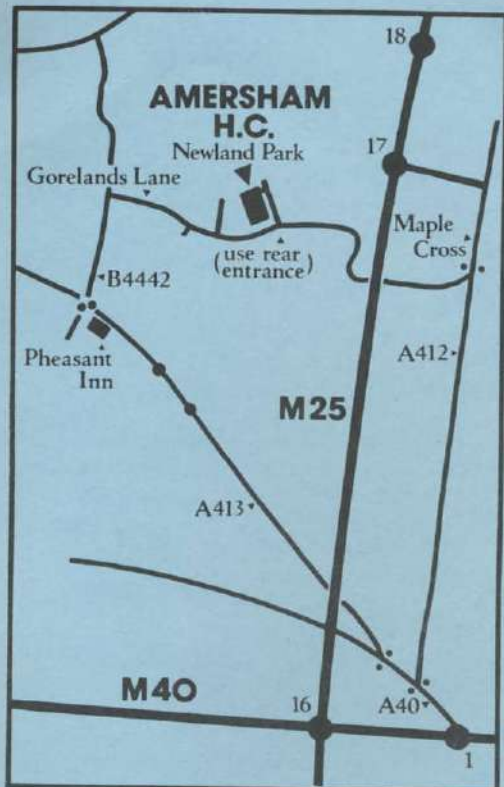
BY ROAD

1) M25 — Leave Junction 17 of the M25 motorway and follow the signs to "Maple Cross". Turn right at the first set of traffic lights (signposted "The Chalfonts"). Continue on this for approximately one mile. You will reach the rear entrance to the campus first; the main entrance is 800 yards further on the same road.

2) A40 — Follow the A40 until you see the signs for the A413 to Amersham. Take the A413 until you reach the village of Chalfont St. Giles (you will find a double mini-roundabout system outside the "Pheasant Inn" public house). At the roundabout take the B4442 away from the village (signposted "Little Chalfont"). The second road on the right is Gorelands Lane and the main entrance to the College is approximately three quarters of a mile along this road.

3) FROM WATFORD — Follow the A412 to Maple Cross, then follow directions as in (1) above.

4) FROM AYLESBURY — Follow the A413 to the mini-roundabout at the "Pheasant Inn", then follow directions as in (2) above.
