AMERSHAM HOCKEY CLUB 1946 -1996

In 1946, at an inaugural meeting of a small band of hockey enthusiasts, called by G. Roberts, Esq., it was decided to form a hockey club to foster the game in the Chenies area. The club was to be called Chenies Hockey Club and would play at the Chenies Cricket ground. The first Annual General Meeting was held in September 1946 and it was proposed to run one eleven under the captaincy of F. G. Smith, Esq. At the second Annual General Meeting G. Quinn, Esq. one of the club's Vice Presidents.

In 1948 the Hon. Secretary was J. Harrison, Esq., who was to fill this role, with the exception of one year, for ten years.

The name of the club was changed to Amersham and Chenies Hockey Club, in 1949. This was brought about by the transfer of ground to Barn Meadow, Amersham. The 1st XI captain of this new named club was E. Fielding-Shaw, who was a Vice President for many years after. It was in this year that along with two other clubs, members took part in the Folkstone Festival under the non-de-plume of "Barnstormers".

In 1951 the club had its third name change, and became Amersham Hockey Club. In 1952 the club moved grounds for the third time and played on the

Amersham Cricket ground at Shardeloes, which it continued to do up to 1955 when it returned to Barn Meadow.

In 1959 Amersham again moved, this time to Elizabeth Avenue as part of the Little Chalfont Sports Club. Amersham were stay at this address for some thirty years and in this time the game itself has changed greatly.

Amersham had arguably its most successful time at Elizabeth Avenue seeing the first eleven promoted from the Middlesex, Bucks, Berks & Oxon league



twice in the 1980's to the Southern Premier League.

Although Amersham have never won the Bucks Hockey Association Cup they were runners up on three occasions, the same is true of the indoor competition - runners up again!

Possibly some of the best moments for anyone



who has played for the club has been when they go on tour. Amersham has sent teams across the country and abroad; Cardiff, Folkstone and Holland have all refused to admit any of the above!

In September 1986 a fire burned down the clubhouse at Elizabeth Avenue and although games were still played at the ground Amersham were without a home for three years.

In 1989 Amersham moved to Newland Park complete with astroturf pitch.

It is with thanks to the many people who have helped to run the club over the years that I wish all involved with Amersham Hockey Club a happy 50th Season and many more to come.

DIRECTIONS

M25

1. Leave Junction 17 of the M25 motorway and follow the signs to "Maple Cross". Turn right at the traffic lights (signposted "The Chalfonts"). Continue on this narrow lane for approximately one mile. The pitch and changing rooms are reached by turning right at the rear entrance and following the road down an avenue of trees until you see the pitch on the left.

A40 - A413

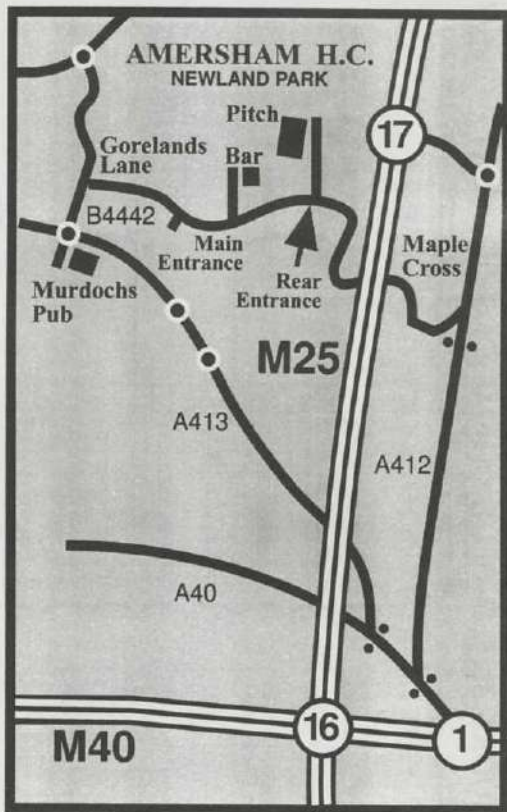
2. Follow the A40 until you see the signs for the A413 to Amersham. Take the A413 until you reach the village of Chalfont St. Giles (you will find a double mini-roundabout system outside the "Murdochs" Public House). At the roundabout turn right up the hill on the B4442 away from the village (signposted "Little Chalfont"). At the brow of the hill turn right into Gorelands Lane, pass the main entrance to the College on the left and continue for half a mile turning left into the rear entrance.

From Watford

Follow the A412 to Maple Cross, then follow the same directions as in (1) above.

From Aylesbury

Follow the A413 to the roundabout at the "Murdochs", then follow the directions as in (2) above.
